

Here are some guidelines for you to prepare your presentation well

- ✓ **Font Type** - Times New Roman (For English medium students)
- ✓ **Font Type for Diacritical marks** - Times_CSX+
- ✓ **Font Type** – FMAbhaya (for Sinhala Medium Students)
- ✓ **Title Font** – between 36 and 44 point
- ✓ **Body Font** – between 24 and 32 point
- ✓ **Bold** – makes the lines of the font thicker
- ✓ **Underline** – places a line under the word
- ✓ **Italic** – slants the tops of the letters of the font to the right
- ✓ **Shadow** – places a dark gray shadow of each letter behind the letter slightly to the right and slightly below the letter
- ✓ **All Caps** –this was an acceptable way to emphasize a word
- ✓ **Word Art** – this feature allows you to distort the letters of the font in a variety of Ways
- ✓ **Highlighting** – this may be the most effective way to emphasize words and is done by placing a colored rectangle behind the text box
- ✓ **Bullet Points**
Using bullet points on a slide is a great way to present the key ideas during a presentation
- ✓ **Bullet Character** – The most popular choices are a filled circle, filled square, open circle, hyphen and arrow
- ✓ **Bullet Size** – Try to select a bullet size slightly smaller than the font of the text so it does not overpower the text itself
- ✓ **Bullet Spacing** – make sure that there is sufficient space between the bullet and the first letter of the text so that the first word is readable

7. Conclusion, presenting the answer to the question posed in Introduction, together with the justification indicating how the chain of reasoning flows from Discussion.
8. Acknowledgements, mentioning the assistance of the library staff as well as teachers helping your throughout the research
