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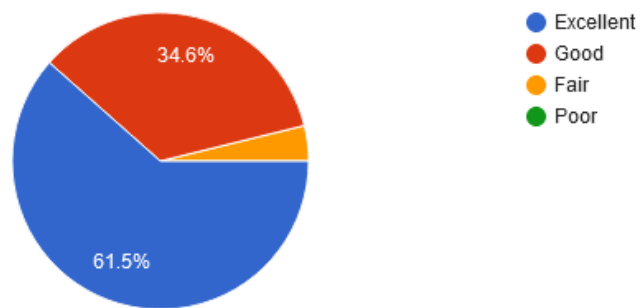

2. How would you rate the usefulness of the content?

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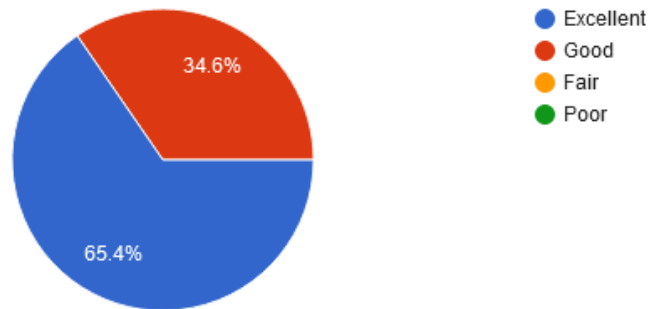

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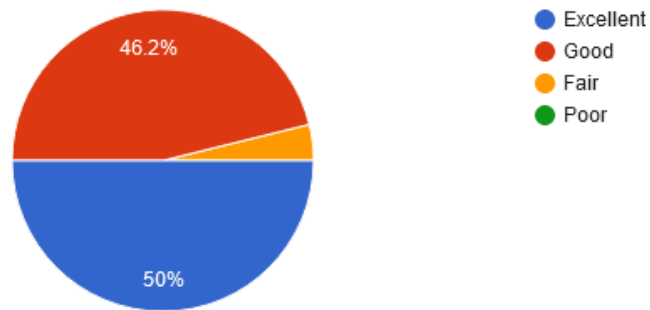

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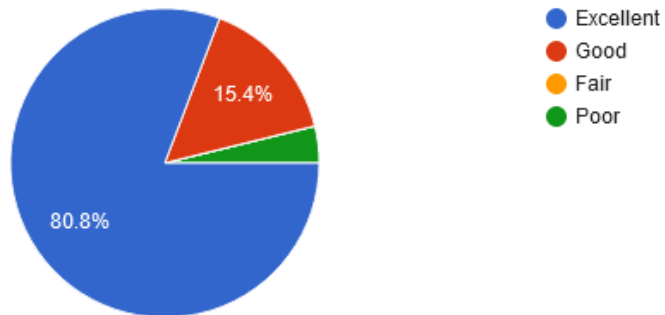

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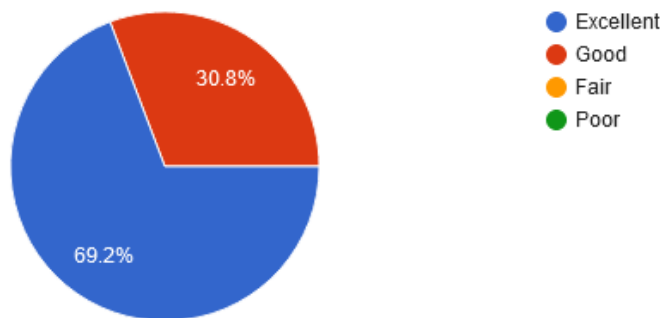
